Section Scope
Old Testament (39 books) Genesis-Malachi

New Testament (27 books) Matthew-Revelation

Main Theme

Creation, Fall, Chosen People, Law, Prophets Life of Jesus, Birth of the Church, Expansion of the Gospel. Eschatology

3. Bible Summary by Theme

1) Genesis-Malachi:

God's plan for His kingdom begins, human sin, the calling and failure of Israel, messianic prophecies.

2) Matthew-Revelation:

Jesus the Messiah comes, crucifixion and resurrection, the establishment of the Church, spread of the gospel, the new heaven and new earth.

4. The Core of the Gospel

- 1) God's Purpose in Creation: Fellowship with humanity.
- 2) Separation Due to Sin: The fall of man and divine judgment.
- 3) God's Plan of Redemption: Salvation through Jesus Christ.
- 4) Work of the Holy Spirit: Spreading the gospel through the Church.
- 5) Eternal Hope: Christ's return and eternal life.
