### 1. Master's Thesis

## 1) Course Objective:

To guide master's students in conducting original theological research on a selected topic and writing a scholarly thesis that meets academic standards.

### 2) Learning Outcomes:

- (1) Select and justify a significant theological or biblical topic for research.
- (2) Analyze relevant literature to establish a solid theoretical foundation.
- (3) Structure the thesis logically and coherently.
- (4) Apply proper academic formatting (e.g., Turabian, APA).
- (5) Prepare for and successfully conduct an oral defense before a faculty panel.

### 3) Core Components:

- (1) Introduction (Research Problem and Purpose)
- (2) Literature Review
- (3) Methodology
- (4) Main Body (Analysis and Interpretation)
- (5) Conclusion (Findings and Recommendations)

#### 4) Supervision and Evaluation:

The student will be guided by at least one advisor and evaluated by a committee through a written thesis and oral defense.
